The agenda items were as follows:

#### 1. Welcome and introduction

The Chair welcomed attendees to the 12<sup>th</sup> extended meeting of the Healthy Bees Plan Project Management Board. Apologies were received from Giles Budge (NBU) and Martha Spagnuolo-Weaver (VMD) who would be invited to a future meeting to cover Veterinary Medicines.

# 2. Review of Phase 1 of Healthy Bees Plan implementation (PMB 12/01 and PMB 12/02)

i) <u>Identify and agree achievements from Phase 1 (for including in Phase 1 progress report)</u>

This consisted of a workshop session intended to gather views regarding the achievements from Phase 1. These views would be incorporated into the draft Progress Report (PMB 12/01).

ii) <u>Identify lessons from governance and working arrangements during Phase 1 and implications for Phase 2 planning, including reports from Chairs of PMB, CWG and SEAG</u>

The Chair asked the Board to identify lessons learned from governance and working arrangements to be incorporated into the draft Progress Report (PMB 12/01).

### iii) Comments on the draft Phase 1 Progress Report

The Chair asked that any additional comments on the draft Progress Report were emailed to the Project Manager.

# 3. <u>Update on business case including any feedback or requirements from</u> Defra's approval process (PMB 11/01)

The Chair confirmed that funding for the first year of Phase 2 had been agreed. However, funding for the following 3 years was subject to a Defra funded Gateway Review by the Office of Government Commerce.

The Chair asked attendees to rank the priorities detailed in PMB 12/03 and to flag any additional priorities. The Chair then asked the Board for their input regarding the setting up of a Research Funders Forum.

## 6. Options on governance for Phase 2 (to be guided by agreed priority deliverables for Phase 2) (Paper PMB 12/04 (and separate annex))

The Board discussed 3 potential options for governance in Phase 2.

#### 7. Review of draft comms plan for Phase 2 (PMB 12/05 and 12/06)

The Board discussed PMB 12/05 and PMB 12/06 which suggested ways to organise marketing and communications activities in a more effective way.

#### 8. Next steps and date of next meeting

The 13<sup>th</sup> meeting was planned for mid April after the BBKA Spring Convention. It was agreed that Mark Tatchell (Chair of SEAG) and Carl Reynolds (Chair of CWG) should be invited.
